

ANALOGY OF THE OLDER STYLE CAMERA The child takes in tiny details and does not discriminate (captured instantly)




ABSORBENT MIND CHARACTERISTICS

Dr. Montessori observed that the child experiences irresistible urges which highlight certain aspects of the environment where learning becomes easy.

sensitive periods direct the absorbent mind



Direct the mind's energy

Children become intensely interested in things they need to learn

Interaction with their environment is heightened
Can acquire knowledge/skills without much effort.

HOW SENSITIVE PERIODS DEVELOP

Internal - taking place inside the child, invisible to us.

External – visible. Little by little by the activity in the environment, it becomes external


